## KINGHAMS INTRODUCTION

**Kinghams Restaurant was opened in 1993 by Chef Proprietor Paul Baker. The Restaurant was named after Paul's late grandfather Reginald Kingham. Mr Kingham's sculpture, created by his daughter, Paul's mother, can be found sitting on the bar at the entrance to the Restaurant.**

**William Blackman built Kinghams Restaurant in approximately 1640, a prosperous time for Shere, thanks to the wool trade. At some point in the 1800's the front door was moved from the front of the building to the side and the building was extended, making what we now call the reception and bar area. It was previously known as Ludsley Pursers, Hangman's Cottage and until the 1970's, Oak Cottage. Former owners include a sheep thief, who was hung at the gibbet, north of Shere!**

**Paul trained at the Royal Lancaster Hotel, London and Ealing College, gaining considerable experience in London restaurants such as Sheekeys Fish Restaurant in St Martins Lane and Stocks Club in the Kings Road.**

## CHAMPAGNE AND SPARKLING WINES

- 1 Lunetta Prosecco Vino Spumante Aromatica di Qualita nv** Italy £ 28.95  
A deliciously light and fruity Prosecco with hints of apple and peach on the nose and a fresh dry, softly sparkling palate.
- 2 Cuvee Edoardo Prosecco Rose nv, Veneto** Italy £36.50  
This is a blend of Pinot Noir, Chardonnay and Glera – the classic grape variety of Prosecco. The 25 hectares lie at 300 metres, allowing for an extended growing season. Aging on lees in oak cask for 9 months adds further complexity to the attractive red fruit notes of strawberry and red currants.
- 3 Champagne Pierre Mignon Grand Reserve Brut nv** France £48.95  
A crisp, well balanced Champagne with citrus hints on the nose overlaid with touches of brioche and yeastiness. The palate is fresh, clean and lively with a creamy mousse and long finish.
- 4 Albury Estate Classic Cuvee** England £ 55.00  
From the Surrey Hills an organic and biodynamic, handpicked sparkling wine. A subtle fruit nose of red berries from the Pinot Noir grape and a little light citrus from the Chardonnay is backed up by a long mouth filling palate that lingers and satisfies. Freshly ripe and lively complimented by a subtle sweetness.
- 5 Champagne Berry Bros & Rudd Grand Cru Brut nv** France £ 59.50  
Sourced from the prestigious Grand Cru village of Mailly, located at the heart of the Montagne de Reims, and benefiting from over three years' ageing, our non-vintage United Kingdom Cuvée is a classic blend of 75 percent Pinot Noir and 25 percent Chardonnay.
- 6 Champagne Billecart Salmon Rose nv** France £ 85.00  
A delightful rose from this highly acclaimed house and much in demand by the cognoscenti. A fruity nose and palate with a hint of roasted nuts.
- 7 Champagne Dom Perignon 2009 Brut** France £ 160.00  
The greatly revered 'Dom Perignon' lends his name to his most famous of Champagnes first launched in 1936. Consistently of very high quality.

### Organic Wines

The simple difference between organic and non-organic is that the grapes used are almost entirely free of synthetic chemicals. The vines will not have been treated with fungicides, pesticides or herbicides with the exception of copper sulphite. Sulphur is used in all wine production but in organic wine it is used less. We have highlighted wines that are organic or where the wine estates embrace organic principles.

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## WHITE WINES

- 19 Pear Tree White Chenin Viognier 2017, South Africa £ 20.95**  
From the cool northern slopes of the Piquetberg. Tropical fruit notes on the nose with hints of guava and lime on the palate, round lingering and fruity.
- 20 Domaine Bertier Sauvignon Viognier 2017 Languedoc France £ 21.95**  
Domaine Bertier is situated near Montpellier, where one finds some of the oldest vineyards in France, the first being planted by the Romans. Fresh and light with vibrant citrus fruits, perfect with seafood and lighter dishes.
- 21 Sunflower PX Sauvignon 2016 Elqui Valley Chile £ 22.50**  
Southern Spain meets the Loire Valley in South America –an unusual and inventive blend. Pedro Ximenez is grown throughout Andalusia here in the Elqui Valley it adds weight texture and a little pique to the fresh herbaceous charms of the omnipresent Sauvignon.
- KR1 Symington Altano 2017 Douro Portugal £23.50**  
Herbal and zesty aromas show tropical fruits; lychees and passion fruit, brimming with youthful vigour. On the palate, exuberantly fresh and piquant, with some green apple notes, great verve and crisp acidity.

- 22 Felines Jourdan Chardonnay Rousanne 2018 Languedoc France £ 23.50**  
Here Chardonnay provides the framework and structure whilst Roussanne adds texture and its distinctive herbal, baked pear and honeyed aromas.
- 23 Pinot Grigio Delle Venezie 2018 Colledelsole Italy £ 24.60**  
A subtle nutty aroma with a touch of spice and a lively palate. A great all-rounder, dry yet with enough weight to be enjoyed on its own or with food.
- 24 Adobe Reserva Sauvignon Blanc 2017 Casablanca Valley Chile £ 25.00**  
 Clean and lively stuff! Translucent light yellow in colour, the complex nose presents citrusy and grapefruit and lime notes with a subtle touch of white pepper and delicate herbs. The smooth palate bursts with freshness balanced by good volume and persistence.
- 25 Dona Javiera Chardonnay 2017 Maipo Valley Chile £ 26.50**  
The Dona Javiera Estate only makes wine from its own vineyards; the grapes being harvested only after strict selection. Their Chardonnay has a pure bright fruit with good balance and flavour
- 26 Sauvignon de Touraine 2017 Domaine de Bellevue France £ 28.50**  
If you enjoy Sancerre then you should really try this from Raphael Midoir. His baby Sancerre has crisp clean fruits and a vibrant acidity. Grown on clay and limestone slopes the vines are low yielding and aged between 5 and 35 years.
- 27 Picpoul de Pinet 2018 Duc De Morny France £ 29.60**  
Floral and enticing on the nose, exuberantly fresh on the palate with pear drop fruit, a slightly salty edge and underlying minerality. Nicknamed la bomba this is incredibly fruity and concentrated Picpoul - yet still fine and elegant, with a very long finish.

## WHITE WINES

- 28 Berrys' White Burgundy 2017, Mâconnais** **France** **£ 30.80**  
 From vineyards nestling on the slopes of the St Veran and Pouilly Fuisse appellation. A ripe and generous Chardonnay from Jean Luc Terrier acknowledged as one of the finest growers in the Maconnais.
- 29 Gavi di Gavi 2018 Roberto Sarotto** **Italy** **£ 32.50**  
 Roberto's Gavi comes from 50 year old Cortese vines. It has both citrus and floral notes with a captivating hint of apricot and peach on the palate.
- 30 Gruner Veltliner Von den Terrassen 2017 Wagram** **Austria** **£ 33.50**  
 Gruner Veltliner is Austria's signature grape variety. Apart from roasts and steak it works well with many dishes. It has a black pepper nose and a lovely textural ripe almost rich fruit on the palate. The Ehmoser vineyards lie on the left the Danube. *Paul's recommendation.*
- 31 Petit Chablis Domaine du Colombier 2017, Burgundy** **France** **£ 37.75**  
 The return of a Kinghams favourite from Guy Mothe at Domaine Colombier. Over the years Guy has built up this Domaine that now covers 33 hectares of prime Chablis vineyards. His Petit Chablis is from the Grand Cru side of the river and his wines are well balanced fruity with perfect acidity.
- 32 Sancerre Les Renarderies 2018 Francois Cherrier** **France** **£ 43.00**  
 Matured on the lees this intense flinty Sancerre from Francois is ripe and vibrant. Very much in tune with the environment in the vineyard and in the cellar –even the rainwater is recycled as part of their efforts.
- 33 Isabel Sauvignon Blanc 2017 Marlborough** **New Zealand** **£ 43.75**  
 Originally founded and owned by Mike Tiller an airline pilot he spotted this perfect site as he flew in and out of Blenheim. Today Jeremy Mackenzie has taken over as winemaker. The vines now matured produce a very considered style of Sauvignon, not racy but more mineral driven with depth and style.
- 34 Chablis Le Bas Chapelot 2016 Domaine Vocoret** **France** **£ 53.50**  
 This Domaine is run by Edouard and Eleni Vocoret who met while making wine in New Zealand. Chapelot is a single plot that lies just below 1er Cru Montee de Tonnerre. A lovely floral and honeysuckle perfume with a perfect mineral balance and classic concentration.
- 35 Gris Pinot Grigio Lis Neris 2015** **Italy** **£ 56.00**  
 From the province of Friuli in north east Italy just outside the village of San Lorenzo. Lis Neris which means Black Ladies in Italian has been owned by the Pecorari family since 1879. 100% Pinot Grigio it is fermented in stainless steel then aged in barrel for 11 months on the lees. No ordinary Pinot Grigio here there is weight.
- 36 Chateauneuf du Pape Blanc Domaine des Senechaux 2013** **France** **£56.00**  
 Senechaux is made up of 30 hectares half of which is on sandy soils near to Ch Rayas. Grenache Blanc, Clairette and Roussanne in roughly equal parts make up the blend with a small amount of Bourboulenc. There is a very pleasing nutty complexity on the palate from the Roussanne which has been barrel fermented.

## WHITE WINES

- 37 Montagny 1<sup>er</sup> Cru 2016** Domaine Jean Marc Boillot **France** **£ 63.00**  
After leaving Domaine Olivier Leflaive where he was the winemaker, Jean Marc set up his Domaine in 1985 with Pommard as its base. His vineyards cover 9 hectares. With its lemon zest fruit on the nose the palate is juicy and ripe with a precise mineral fruit.
- 38 Chateau des Rontets Pouilly-Fuisse 2015** Maconnais **France** **£66.00**  
The 2015 Pouilly Fuisse Clos Varambon has a relatively simple but not unattractive bouquet with dried pineapple and beeswax aromas. The palate is well balanced with a fine line of acidity, more lime fruit than many others with a brisk, quite tensile finish and a dash of spice on the aftertaste. Easy-going undeniably but I think that this is a well made Pouilly-Fuisse
- 39 Meursault Grand Charrons 2015** Michel Bouzereau **France** **£ 85.50**  
 This is a perfect example of Jean-Luc Baptiste Bouzereau's knack of making soft approachable Meursault. From as far back as 1861 Grand Charrons has been recognised as a vineyard producing very fine wines.
- 40 Chassagne Montrachet Les Baudines 1er Cru 2015** **France** **£97.00**  
From the highly talented Benjamin Leroux of Domaine Comte Armand. Baudines lies at the top of the slope at the southern end of the village – the soil being made up of deep white clay. Plenty of ripe mineral fruit with a layer of soft oak.

- H71 Petit Chablis 2017** Domaine du Colombier **France** **£22.50**  
This single Domaine makes exemplary Chablis, crisp mineral fruit.
- H72 Sancerre Les Renarderies 2017** Francois Cherrier **France** **£ 24.00**  
Matured on the lees this intense flinty Sancerre from Francois is ripe and vibrant.

### Red Wines

- H73 Brouilly Alain Michaud 2017** Beaujolais **France** **£ 23.50**  
 A very elegant wine with young ripe fruits from the Gamay grape.
- H74 Domaine Drouhin Pinot Noir 2015** Dundee Hills **N.America** **£ 31.95**  
French Soul, Oregon Soil. The Dundee Hills Pinot Noir is a wine of superb balance, elegance and finesse. It is lovely on release and has a history of ageing well.

## RED WINES

- 41 Big Oak Red Shiraz & Cab Sauvignon 2015,** **S. Africa** **£ 20.95**  
 Medium bodied with blackcurrant fruits from the Cabernet and mulberry fruits with a touch of spice from the Shiraz.
- 42 Montepulciano d' Abruzzo 2017** **Abruzzi** **Italy** **£ 21.50**  
 Montepulciano is grown extensively in central and eastern Italy. Deep ruby in colour with an enticing aroma of cherries and freshly baked bread. The ripe fruit notes abound on the palate along with a juicy rich background.
- 43 Pietas Carignan Vieilles Vignes 2017,** **Herault** **France** **£ 23.75**  
 Carignan is the indigenous grape of the Herault and this wine comes from 40 year old vines growing on the hillside around Carcassone. There is a ripe juicy full bodied fruit. Plenty of red berry notes with a hint of vanilla and spice.
- KR2 Alabastro 2017** **Vinho Regional Alentejano,** **Portugal** **£24.50**  
 From one of Portugal's most progressive producers this spicy red is packed full of ripe plums and raspberries with a generous rounded finish.  
*Kinghams Recommendation.*
- 44 Kraal Bay Pinotage 2018,** **Swartland** **South Africa** **£ 25.95**  
 Pinotage is very much South Africa's own grape variety. It was created by Professor Perold of Stellenbosch University in 1925. Here he crossed Pinot Noir and Cinsault to create the variety. Coming from Swartland to the north of Cape Town the wine has a mulberry, blackberry and damson fruit with a toasted marshmallow note on the palate.
- 45 Berrys' Good Ordinary Claret 2016** **Bordeaux** **France** **£ 27.75**  
 There is nothing ordinary about this exceptional Claret! Merlot dominated with pure black and red fruits on the palate. Soft silky and elegant. Matured for one year in new French oak in Dourthe's cellars in the Graves.
- 46 Berrys' Côtes du Rhône 2017** **Rhone** **France** **£27.75**  
 Notes of crushed strawberries, balanced by a beautiful freshness of spices from Provence and its Garrigues. On the palate, this wine is beautifully balanced in richness and freshness, a good structure with fine tannins.
- 47 Stone the Crows Shiraz Cabernet 2016,** **South East** **Australia** **£ 28.95**  
 This is a traditional spicy Aussie Shiraz that has been blended with a deft infusion of Cabernet adding a savoury note and fine structure.
- 48 Francois Lurton Pinot Noir, 2017** **Languedoc** **France** **£ 29.50**  
 Bright cherry red colour. The nose is fine and elegant with aromas of morello cherry and blackcurrant which predominate and are accompanied by notes of spice. There is a long finish of red fruit flavours
- 49 Cerro Anon Rioja Crianza 2015,** **Rioja** **Spain** **£ 29.95**  
 Bodegas Olarra was created in 1973 and is situated on the outskirts of Logrono in the Rioja Alta. A blend of Tempranillo Garnacha and Mazuelo, it spends 14 months in oak. It is spicy yet mellow with a round long finish.
- 50 Pulenta la Flor Malbec 2018,** **Mendoza** **Argentina** **£34.00**  
 Originally from France and found in Bordeaux until phylloxera struck it is still grown in Cahors. Malbec is now very much at home here in Argentina. As you might imagine it is especially good with steaks! Ripe juicy fruits.

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## RED WINES

- 51 Ch Lucas Lussac St Emilion 2014, Bordeaux** **France** **£ 37.00**  
Ch Lucas lies approximately 45kms east of Bordeaux. It belongs to the Vautier family who also own Ch Ausone. It is a blend of 50% Merlot fruit and 50% Cabernet Franc. An enticing nose of ripe red fruits and on the palate a mellow spice character that is both long and well structured.
- 52 Valpolicella Ripasso 2016, Veneto** **Italy** **£ 40.00**  
A classic Ripasso with dense cherry fruits, rich and rewarding. Ripasso is made by adding unpressed Amarone grapes to the must during fermentation. Ideal with the rich hearty meat dishes of winter.
- 53 Mullineux Kloof Street Red 2016, Swartland** **South Africa** **£41.50**  
This Rhone varietal cuvee is made up of Cinsault, Carignan, Grenache, Mourvedre and Syrah. It is aged for one year in old oak casks. Red fruits and spice dominate the aroma and the palate is attractive and juicy making this a very quaffable red. *Jack's Recommendation.*
- 54 Fleurie La Roilette Bernard Metrat 2016, Beaujolais** **France** **£41.95**  
The most famous of the Beaujolais Cru from vines planted in 1924 and 1936. There is plenty of concentration with a dense vibrant fruit. A stylish wine combining power and juiciness very similar to his wine of 2010.
- 55 Berrys' Extra Ordinary Claret 2015, Bordeaux** **France** **£43.50**  
This is the 13<sup>th</sup> vintage of EOC. The fruit comes from a beautiful Graves estate belonging to the J M Cazes family. Merlot dominates with a rich briary fruit, vanilla and hints of mocha. Medium bodied well rounded with a juicy black fruit.
- 56 Dean Hewitson Baby Bush Mourvedre 2015, Barossa** **Australia** **£ 46.50**  
The cuttings for this wine came from the oldest surviving Mourvedre bush vines in the world dating back to 1853 known as Old Garden here in the Barossa. With dark cherry fruits and a note of pepper and spice the fine ripe tannins are smoothly round and balanced on the finish.
- 57 Isabel Pinot Noir 2015, Marlborough** **New Zealand** **£ 54.00**  
Mike and Robyn Tiller founded Isabel Estate in 1982 from the outset to goal was to grow only premium grape varieties. It was one of the few remaining family run estates in Marlborough until taken over by Pinnacle. This Pinot has a lovely balance and concentration yet is delicate and fine.
- 58 Châteauneuf du Pape 2015** **France** **£ 59.95**  
 Run by Frank and Murielle Mousset this perfect 4ha plot is superbly located in the Courthezon commune. With low yields and minimal intervention this 100% Grenache is packed full of dark fruits and rich chocolate notes.
- 59 Ridge East Bench Zinfandel 2016** **N. America** **£74.00**  
Ridge has made the East Bench as a single-site zinfandel since 2006. A nose of rich raspberry and pepper accompanied by floral and mineral notes. The palate is layered with dark cherry and black currant fruit, mineral, and cocoa. Balanced acidity with fine tannins on the finish.

## RED WINES

- 60 Lopez de Heredia Vina Tondonia Reserva 2005 Tinto Spain £ 75.50**  
75% Tempranillo 15% Garnacha and the balance being made up of Craciano and Mazuelo. Having spent 6 years in barrel and 6 years in bottle the wine retains a core of rich red forest floor fruits complemented by a layer of sweet spice. This is archetypal traditional Rioja with a balanced but notable acidity - a trademark of all great Rioja's
- 61 Gevrey Chambertin Louis Boillot 2015 Burgundy France £ 76.95**  
Louis is descended from the Volnay family of Boillot's his partner Ghislaine Barthod is equally famous in the Cote de Nuits. This lovely Gevrey is purple in colour with a very pretty fruit on the nose. The palate has deep raspberry notes with plenty of energy and little mineral notes on the finish.
- 62 Campogiovanni Brunello di Montalcino 2012 Italy £84.00**  
Pretty and refined on the palate, with fine tannins, mouth watering acidity, a lightness of touch, and a lovely purity of cool red fruit with a touch of orange peel. Some spicy notes from time in large oak barrels, a mineral spine, and a long finish.
- 63 Barolo Fratelli Alessandria, Piedmont 2013 Italy £91.00**  
Luciano's Barolo is made in an elegant modern style with a perfect balance of smoke tar liquorice and dark plum fruits and a fine silky elegance. Le Vigne is a single vineyard wine made from the fabulous Nebbiolo grape variety.
- 64 Nuits-St Georges, Clos de la Maréchale, 1er Cru, 2014 France £129.00**  
Dense, purple, rugged and backward, with a big weight of fruit and high acidity. Medium-deep red fruit pervades the palate and, as always with this wine, the finish is seamless. This is a beautifully-crafted medium-plus bodied Clos de la Maréchale.
- 65 Ch Gruaud Larose 2eme Cru 2006 St Julien Bordeaux France £185.00**  
Gruaud's 1995 is a real tour de force with all the characteristic lush St Julien fruit allied with a rich deep palate of blackcurrant and raspberry notes. Drinking very well now at age twenty two this wine will still be showing well come thirty years of age

- H75 Muscat de Beames de Venise 2016 Domaine Durban ½ bottle £ 28.95**  
A very fresh and citrus bouquet lifts the sweet and liquorish palate. **by the glass £5.00**

- 77 Kinghams House Port by the glass £ 4.95**  
A blend of 4-year-old wine from vineyards near Pinhao.
- H78 Quinta de la Rosa Tonnix LBV 2009 half bottle £ 30.50**  
A ripe full flavoured Port with plenty of fruit and body.
- 79 Berrys' 2007 Bottled Crusted Port by the bottle £ 49.50**  
As this wine has thrown a deposit it requires decanting please allow time.  
From the house of Dow's. Richly decadent.
