| This special Rose is hand-picked from the vineyard plots of La Planna and La Barbara along with Monastrell grapes grown on the terraces of El Serral which defines the personality of De Nit. Very elegant with a fresh white fruit aroma and a dash of cassis, the palate is smooth and fruity with a lingering finish. | | |

| From the Surrey Hills an organic and biodynamic, handpicked sparkling wine. A subtle fruit nose of red berries from the Pinot Noir grape and a little light citrus from the Chardonnay is backed up by a long mouth filling palate that lingers and satisfies. Freshly ripe and lively complimented by a subtle sweetness. | | |
| 8 Champagne Jacquesson Cuvée 738 Brut nv | France | £ 55.00 |
| Cuvee 737 is based on the 2010 harvest, a classic blend of Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier from Premier and Grand Cru villages. Complex and full bodied with a lovely line of mineral ripe fruit and very satisfying. | | |
| 9 Champagne Billecart Salmon Rose nv | France | £ 75.00 |
| A delightful rose from this highly acclaimed house and much in demand by the cognoscenti. A fruity nose and palate with a hint of roasted nuts. | | |

KR1	Eusebia Chardonnay Roussanne 2014,	France	£21.95
	An unusual and relatively rare blend found in warm climates. Chardonnay provides much of the framework and structure whilst the Roussanne adds body texture and its distinctive herbal and baked pear/honeyed aromas. This wine is full bodied with a rounded mouthfeel.		
KR3	Silent Pool Rose 2013, Surrey	England	£27.50
	A blend of Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier from organic grapes grown in the Surrey Hills. Fresh red berry and redcurrant aromas. Full flavoured palate with an elegant juicy fruit and a crisp, tart finish.		
KR2	Cotes de Ventoux Rouge Famillee Perrin 2014,	France	£ 21.95
	Mont Ventoux lies on the fringes of the Rhone Valley. This is a medium bodied fresh and very food friendly red. It is a blend of classic Rhone varieties, and in no particular order of Grenache, Cinsault, Syrah, Mourvedre and Carignan.		

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WHITE WINES

- 19 Porter Mill Station Chenin Blanc 2015** Swartland **South Africa** **£ 19.50**
From the cool northern slopes of the Piquetberg. Tropical fruit notes on the nose with hints of guava and lime on the palate, round lingering and fruity.
- 20 Domaine Bertier Sauvignon Viognier 2014** Languedoc **France** **£ 19.95**
Domaine Bertier is situated near Montpellier, where one finds some of the oldest vineyards in France, the first being planted by the Romans. Fresh and light with vibrant citrus fruits, perfect with seafood and lighter dishes.
- 21 Dona Javiera Chardonnay 2015** Maipo Valley **Chile** **£ 20.50**
The Dona Javiera Estate only makes wine from its own vineyards; the grapes are hand harvested after strict selection. Their Chardonnay has a pure bright fruit with good balance and flavour.
- 22 Pinot Grigio Bertoldi 2014** Veneto **Italy** **£ 21.00**
A subtle nutty aroma with a touch of spice and a lively palate. A great all rounder, dry yet with enough weight to be enjoyed on its own or with food.
- 23 Pulenta Estate Pinot Gris 2015** Mendoza **Argentina** **£ 23.75**
This is a fruity, characterful wine ideally suited to white meat and spicy dishes. Never having been cultivated before the land for these vineyards is completely disease and pest free and therefore needs no artificial controls.
- 24 Vista Hermosa Sauvignon 2014** Casablanca Valley **Chile** **£ 24.50**
A crisply refreshing Sauvignon from a group of growers known locally as the "Casablanca Valley Boys". This cool climate valley produces sensational pure clean and ripe fruits and this shines through on the palate.
- 25 Muscadet Domaine la Moriniere 2014** Loire **France** **£ 24.95**
A delightful and lively sur lie Muscadet with a leafy character and ripe fruit. Made from old vines and with time in cask spent on the lees. Plenty of crisp dry mineral fruit.
- 26 Picpoul de Pinet 2014** Domaine Felines Jourdan **France** **£ 26.00**
A dry white that is great with seafood and in particular oysters. The vineyards lie planted back from the coast between Sete and Beziers. Picpoul is an old established variety that is enjoying a great revival with a hint of citrus, pear and fennel notes on the palate.
- 27 Sauvignon de Touraine 2014** Domaine de Bellevue **France** **£ 26.50**
If you enjoy Sancerre then you should really try this from Raphael Midoir. Crisp clean fruits with a vibrant acidity. Grown on clay / limestone soil the vines are low yielding and are aged between 5 and 35 years.
- 28 Berrys' White Burgundy 2014,** Mâconnais **France** **£ 28.50**
From vineyards nestling on the slopes of the St Veran and Pouilly Fuisse appellation. A ripe and generous Chardonnay from Jean Luc Terrier acknowledged as one of the finest growers in the Maconnais.

Organic Wines

 The simple difference between organic and non-organic is that the grapes used are almost entirely free of synthetic chemicals. The vines will not have been treated with fungicides, pesticides or herbicides with the exception of copper sulphite. Sulphur is used in all wine production but in organic wine it is used less. We have highlighted wines that are organic or where the wine estates embrace organic principles.

CLASSIC WHITE WINES

- 29 Gavi di Gavi 2014** Roberto Sarotto **Italy** **£ 28.50**
 Roberto's Gavi comes from 50 year old Cortese vines. It has both citrus and floral notes with a captivating hint of apricot and peach on the palate.
- 30 Gobelsburger Gruner Veltliner 2010** Kremstal **Austria** **£ 32.00**
 Gruner Veltliner is Austria's signature grape variety and one Kinghams Chef Proprietor Paul thoroughly recommends. Apart from roasts and steak it works well with many dishes. It has a black pepper nose and a lovely textural ripe almost rich fruit on the palate. The Kremstal vineyards look down onto the Danube.
- 31 Petit Chablis Domaine du Colombier 2014**, Burgundy **France** **£33.50**
 The return of a Kinghams favourite from Guy Mothe at Domaine Colombier. Over the years Guy has built up this Domaine that now covers 33 hectares of prime Chablis vineyards. His Petit Chablis is from the Grand Cru side of the river and his wines are well balanced fruity with perfect acidity.
- 60 Sancerre Rose Domaine Epsailles 2014**, Loire **France** **£ 37.50**
 This delicate salmon pink Rose is made from the Pinot Noir grape. Softly fruity with notes of strawberry and redcurrant on the nose and a fine clean mineral fruit on the finish.
- 32 Sancerre Les Renarderies 2014** Francois Cherrier **France** **£ 37.95**
 Matured on the lees this intense flinty Sancerre from Francois is ripe and vibrant. Very much in tune with the environment in the vineyard and in the cellar –even the rainwater is recycled as part of their efforts.
- 33 Isabel Sauvignon Blanc 2014** Marlborough **New Zealand** **£ 38.95**
 Originally founded and owned by Mike Tiller an airline pilot he spotted this perfect site as he flew in and out of Blenheim. Today Jeremy Mackenzie has taken over as winemaker. The vines now matured produce a very considered style of Sauvignon, not racy but more mineral driven with depth and style.
- 34 Chablis 1er Cru Montmains 2014** Denis Race **France** **£ 47.50**
 A full ripe Chablis with excellent balance and acidity. Denis has a parcel of 60 year old vines that goes to make up this fine example
- 35 Montagny 1^{er} Cru 2013** Domaine Jean Marc Boillot **France** **£ 59.95**
 After leaving Domaine Olivier Leflaive where he was the winemaker, Jean Marc set up his Domaine in 1985 with Pommard as its base. His vineyards cover 9 hectares. With its lemon zest fruit on the nose the palate is juicy and ripe with a precise mineral fruit.
- 36 Meursault Grand Charrons 2011** Michel Bouzereau **France** **£ 75.00**
 This is a perfect example of Jean-Luc Baptiste Bouzereau's knack of making soft approachable Meursault. From as far back as 1861 Grand Charrons has been recognised as a vineyard producing very fine wines.

William Blackman built Kinghams Restaurant in approximately 1620, a prosperous time for Shere, thanks to the wool trade. It was previously known as Ludsley Pursers, Hangman's and until the 1970's, Oak Cottage. Former owners include a family of sheep thieves, one of whom was hung at the gibbet, north of Shere!

RED WINES

- 37 Dona Javiera Cabernet Sauvignon 2015** Maule Valley **Chile** **£ 19.50**
 Cabernet Sauvignon on its own is a difficult grape variety needing warm conditions to ripen. Thus in Europe it benefits from blending. However here in Chile the climate provides ample sunshine to properly ripen the grapes making for a succulent ripe palate with notes of dark berry fruits.
- 38 Pietas Carignan Vieilles Vignes 2015**, Herault **France** **£ 20.95**
 Carignan is the indigenous grape of the Herault and this wine comes from 40 year old vines growing on the hillside around Carcassone. There is a ripe juicy full bodied fruit. Plenty of red berry notes with a hint of vanilla and lots of spice.
- 39 Porter Mill Station Pinotage 2014**, Tulbach **South Africa** **£ 22.95**
 Founded in 1906 this estate is part of the Tulbach Winery one of the oldest Co Operative cellars in South Africa. Pinotage is very much South Africa's own grape variety. It was created by Professor Perold of Stellenbosch University in 1925. Here he crossed Pinot Noir and Cinsault to create the variety. The wine is unique with notes of mulberry, blackberry, damson and even toasted marshmallows.
- 40 Bardolino 2015** Monte del Fra Veneto **Italy** **£ 24.50**
 Monte del Fra "Hill of Monks" produces wines that are clean, fresh and fruit driven. The taste is noticeably Italian being stylish, perfumed and elegant.
- 41 Berrys' Good Ordinary Claret 2013** Bordeaux **France** **£ 24.95**
 There is nothing ordinary about this exceptional Claret! Merlot dominated with pure black and red fruits on the palate. Soft silky and elegant. Matured for one year in new French oak in Dourthe's cellars in the Graves.
- 42 Berrys' Cotes du Rhone 2012**, Rhone **France** **£26.50**
 The Perrin family is the most respected vinous dynasty in the south of France. The attention to detail and the sheer quality of the grapes and skill which underwrites their greatness are both evident in this outstanding wine from 2011. Red berry aromatics with a dash of pepper and spice underline provenance and ensure satisfaction. 70% Grenache blended with 30% Syrah.
- 43 Domaine Coudoulet Pinot Noir 2015**, Languedoc **France** **£ 27.00**
 A serious and well priced Pinot with more than a nod towards Burgundy. Brother's Jean Yves and Pierre Andre Ournac have produced a Pinot with ripe cherry and strawberry fruits and smooth soft tannins.
- 44 Cerro Anon Rioja Crianza 2012** Rioja **Spain** **£ 27.50**
 Bodegas Olarra was created in 1973 and is situated on the outskirts of Logrono in the Rioja Alta. A blend of Tempranillo Garnacha and Mazuelo it spends 14 months in oak. It is spicy yet mellow with a round long finish.
- 45 La Flor Malbec 2015** Mendoza **Argentina** **£ 28.50**
 Originally from France and found in Bordeaux until phylloxera struck and still grown today in Cahors. Malbec is now very much at home here in Argentina. As you might imagine it is especially good with steaks! Ripe juicy bright fruits.
- 46 Stone the Crows Shiraz Cabernet 2014** South East **Australia** **£ 29.50**
 This is a traditional spicy Aussie Shiraz that has been blended with a deft infusion of Cabernet adding a savoury note and fine structure.

CLASSIC RED WINES

- 47 Ch Lucas Lussac St Emilion 2011, Bordeaux France £ 33.50**
Ch Lucas lies approximately 45kms east of Bordeaux. It belongs to the Vautier family who also own Ch Ausone. It is a blend of 50% Merlot fruit and 50% Cabernet Franc. An enticing nose of ripe red fruits and on the palate a mellow spice character that is both long and well structured.
- 48 Peachy Canyon Incredible Zinfandel 2013, Paso Robles N America £ 34.95**
Zinfandel arrived in America via Italy where it is known as Primitivo and was originally from Croatia. This is a ripe juicy red with plenty of good hearty fruit and flavour – you can quite see why the gold diggers favourite in the 1850's
- 49 Valpolicella Ripasso 2013, Veneto Italy £35.50**
A classico Ripasso with dense cherry fruits, rich and rewarding. Ripasso is made by adding unpressed Amarone grapes to the must during fermentation. Ideal with the rich hearty meat dishes of winter.
- 50 Fleurie La Roilette Bernard Metrat 2014, Beaujolais France £37.95**
The most famous of the Beaujolais Cru from vines planted in 1924 and 1936. There is plenty of concentration with a dense vibrant fruit. A stylish wine combining power and juiciness very similar to his wine of 2010.
- 51 Berrys' Extra Ordinary Claret 2013, Bordeaux France £39.50**
This is the 12th vintage of EOC. The fruit comes from a beautiful Graves estate belonging to the J M Cazes family. Merlot dominates with a rich briary fruit, vanilla and hints of mocha. Medium bodied well rounded with a juicy black fruit.
- 52 Ch Petit Val Grand Cru St Emilion 2012, Bordeaux France £ 49.95**
From the right bank of the Gironde river. Merlot with a dash of Cabernet Franc. Bright and fruity with an open freshness and easy style on the palate and soft plum notes. The Chateau lies on a prime site just a mile from St Emilion town centre.
- 53 Isabel Pinot Noir 2013, Marlborough New Zealand £ 54.00**
Mike and Robyn Tiller founded Isabel Estate in 1982 from the outset to goal was to grow only premium grape varieties. It was one of the few remaining family run estates in Marlborough until taken over by Pinnacle. This Pinot has a lovely balance and concentration yet is delicate and fine.
- 54 Châteauneuf du Pape 2013 Domaine des Saumades France £ 59.95**
 Run by Frank and Murielle Mousset this perfect 4ha plot is superbly located in the Courthezon commune. With low yields and minimal intervention this 100% Grenache is packed full of dark fruits and rich chocolate notes.
- 55 Nuits St Georges V V P & M Rion 2011 Burgundy France £ 75.50**
 Until 2000 Patrice was winemaker at his family's estate when he left to start his own negociant business with his wife Michele. Strict canopy management and low yields have produced focussed pure Pinot Noir with an elegant silky finish..
- 76 Duluc de Brinaire Ducru St Julien 2008 Bordeaux France £ 78.00**
From the golden triangle of St Julien soil made up of deep gravel and clay. Lying just 900 metres away from the brooding swell of the Gironde estuary. Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot makes up the blend. Mature black cherry ripe fruits with a well-balanced maturing fruit on the palate.

Fresh clean and lively with touches of brioche and yeastiness

White Wines

- H66 Muscadet de Sèvre-et-Maine sur lie 2014** La Morinière France £ 14.95
From 30-year-old vines the wine is crisp and clean with a mineral note.
- H67 Petit Chablis 2014** Domaine du Colombier France £ 18.90
This single Domaine makes exemplary Chablis, crisp mineral fruit.
- H68 Pouilly Fumé Les Cocques 2014** P Coulbois France £ 20.90
A perfect soil for the Sauvignon grape: clay, flintstone and Portland limestone.
A floral fruity style.

Red Wines

- H69 Ch Reynier 2011** Bordeaux France £ 15.50
This easy-drinking cabernet is smooth, characterful and satisfying.
- H70 Brouilly Alain Michaud 2013** Beaujolais France £ 20.50
A very elegant wine with young ripe fruits from the Gamay grape.
- H71 Ch Petit Val Grand Cru St Emilion 2011** France £ 26.95
Soft plum fruits and very approachable

Sweet Wines

- H72 Muscat de Beaumes de Venise 2013** Domaine Durban ½ bottle £ 26.50
A very fresh and citrus bouquet lifts the sweet and liquorish palate. **by the glass** £4.50
- 73 Ch de Cerons 2007,** Bordeaux France ½ bottle £31.50
This is a delicious sweet wine with a perfect balance of concentration
Lovely energy on the palate with aromas of acacia, honey and passion
fruit. Mainly Semillon with a dash of Sauvignon to help.

Port

- 74 Kinghams House Port** by the glass £ 4.95
A blend of 4-year-old wine from vineyards near Pinhao.
- H75 Quinta de la Rosa Finest Reserve** half bottle £ 24.50
A ripe full flavoured Port with plenty of fruit and body.

White Wines

- 56 Vina Tondonia Blanco Reserva 1999** Lopez de Heredia **Spain** **£48.00**
This fine Rioja is made from 90% Viura and 10% Malvasia. It has been aged in barrel for 6 years unusual in a red wine let alone a white! When mature Viura is one of wines great treasures with wax and deep honey and pebble stone notes. Well worth the effort if at first it appears different – and it's meant to be.
- 57 Chateaufeuf du Pape Blanc Domaine des Senechaux 2012** **France** **£56.00**
Senechaux is made up of 30 hectares half of which is on sandy soils near to Ch Rayas. Grenache Blanc, Clairette and Roussanne in roughly equal parts make up the blend with a small amount of Bourboulenc. There is a very pleasing nutty complexity on the palate from the Roussanne which has been barrel fermented.
- 58 Chablis Valmur Grand Cru 2013** Domaine JC Bessin **France** **£64.00**
Valmur is one of only seven Grand Cru of Chablis, these are the biggest richest and most complex of all the wines. Valmur is renowned for its fine bouquet and ripe fruit. A great match to go with fish, particularly Dover Sole.
- 59 Chassagne Montrachet Les Baudines 1^{er} Cru 2012** **France** **£97.00**
From the highly talented Benjamin Leroux of Domaine Comte Armand. Baudines lies at the top of the slope at the southern end of the village – the soil being made up of deep white clay. Plenty of ripe mineral fruit with a layer of soft oak.

Red Wines

- 61 Ridge Geyserville 2013**, Alexander Valley **N. America** **£60.00**
Geyserville is a field blend of old vines, 73% Zinfandel, 17% Carignane, 9% Petite Sirah and 1% Mataro (Mourvedre) Black cherry and plum fruits with toasted oak and a gravel rock minerality coming from the ancient river bed that the vines grow on. Deep bramble blackberry fruits sensuous and multi layered.
- 62 Barolo Cannubi Le Vigne 2009** Luciano Sandrone **Italy** **£138.00**
Luciano's Barolo is made in an elegant modern style with a perfect balance of smoke tar liquorice and dark plum fruits and a fine silky elegance. Le Vigne is a single vineyard wine made from the fabulous Nebbiolo grape variety.
- 63 Chambolle Musigny Les Cras 2008** Domaine Meo Camuzet **France** **£155.00**
Meo Camuzet is one of the undisputed star estates in Burgundy it is run by Jean Nicolas Meo. This Chambolle is racy and mineral with plenty of personality.
- 64 Domaine de Chevalier Rouge 1989**, Pessac Leognan **France** **£160.00**
This is one of the few Graves properties producing 1st class red and white wines. The superb Chevalier vintage of 1989 is plump and forward merging sweet cherry and blackcurrant aromas with a delicious hint of herbs and fleshy fruit. Silky smooth and supremely integrated.

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
